Petitioners has approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 07.11.2016 passed by this Court.

It is not disputed that the petitioner has been paid an *ex gratia* amount of ₹2,50,000/- which has been credited to her account in compliance with the order passed by this Court. Further it is the claim of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was entitled to lump sum amount of *ex gratia* at the rate of ₹5,00,000/- as provided under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance & Employment to the dependents of deceased Government employees Rules 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the '2005 Rules').

Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner and on going through the 2005 Rules, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner would only be entitled to an *ex gratia* amount of ₹2,50,000/- as per the old rules of 2003 as the 2005 rules specifically have provided that the pending cases of all those Government employees whose family members were eligible under the 2003 Rules which were repealed with the coming into effect of the 2005 Rules shall be disposed of
