Petitioner is a beneficiary of an award dated 16.3.2017 passed by the Labour Court,Hisar in his favour whereby reinstatement with continuity of service has been granted.

In CWP 25587/2017 filed by the employer Department, this Court while issuing notice of motion has made a conditional stay of the award i.e. subject to compliance of Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act,1947.

Present contempt has been filed alleging that there is no compliance of Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act,1947.

At the time of hearing realizing that due to non-compliance, the award itself becomes executable, counsel prays for permission to withdraw the present contempt petition so as to enable the petitioner to avail alternative remedy.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
