AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

An amount of ₹3,753/- which is stated to be the amount due towards the petitioner, as per the order dated 30.05.2017 passed by this Court, has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner in cash in Court, which has been accepted by the counsel for the petitioner under protest. He states that the entire calculations which have been made by the respondents are not correct and the interest which has been calculated by them is not as per the order passed by this Court. He has produced his calculations, according to which the total amount comes to ₹7,75,710/-.

In the light of the fact that there are disputes with regard to the calculations, which this Court is unable to resolve, the present contempt petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail of his remedy in accordance with law including filing of an execution petition.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
