Petitioner-Teka alleges the violation of the order dated 29.08.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) passed in writ petition bearing *CWP No. 17592 of 2016* filed by him, whereby a direction was issued to competent authority to finalize the proceedings pending before him in pursuance to the ejectment petition preferred by the petitioner expeditiously and preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

At the time of hearing, counsel for the petitioner states that the order in question has been complied with, therefore, concedes no further action in present contempt petition is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
