The dispute is concerning to the enrolment of members of the Kansal Rural Co-operative House Building Society Limited, which is registered under the Punjab Co-operative Societies Act, 1961.

Petitioners had filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No.5361 of 2017* seeking quashing of public notice dated 21.02.2017 wherein the consideration of members of the Society for holding elections to the Managing Committee was limited to the extent of 195 members.

The aforesaid writ petition was disposed of vide order dated 16.03.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this Court, therefore, the petitioners allege the violation of the said order dated 16.03.2017 (**P-1**), wherein it is

directed 'to the Administrator to consider the objections filed by the petitioners and orders regarding the enrolment of the members to be considered upto 13.02.2013 and the Administrator shall consider the same after giving proper opportunity of hearing to the petitioners regarding preparation of list of members and thereafter, pass a speaking order within a period of ten days'.

Since the order in question has not been complied with, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, a reply stands filed, wherein, in para No. 3, it is stated that in compliance of the order dated 16.03.2017 **(P-1)**, the petitioners had submitted objections regarding the enrolment of members and the same have been decided, by passing a speaking order dated 06.04.2017.

In view of above reply, learned State Counsel states that the order in question has been complied with, therefore, no further action in the present contempt petition is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
