Petitioner's appeal was allowed by the Commissioner, Yamuna Nagar whereby the order of Collector appointing Sushil Kumar as *Lambardar* of village Panjeto Tehsil Chacharauli, Yamuna Nagar was set aside. The revision filed by Sushil Kumar was dismissed by the learned Financial Commissioner, Ambala vide order dated 10.09.2013 and CWP No.23831 of 2013 filed by Sushil Kumar before this court was allowed vide order dated 06.03.2014 and the matter was remanded back to the Financial Commissioner for deciding the matter afresh.

Petitioner has filed the present contempt with the allegations that no proceedings have been initiated by the Revisional Court inspite of the directions passed by this Court on 06.03.2014.

At the time of hearing, counsel for the petitioner realizing that no contempt is made out, prays for permission to withdraw the present

contempt so as to enable his client to seek his remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
