JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Wazir Singh (since deceased) and Kuldeep Singh are stated to have purchased land measuring 09 Kanals 18 Marlas situated in village Chao Majra, Tehsil and District Mohali vide sale deed dated 18.11.2004. A Civil dispute regarding the right/title of the vendors, who had inherited the property from the previous owner Mehar Singh arose between the family members of the vendors, in which the two brothers/vendees also were arrayed as parties. In the meanwhile the land stood acquired under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 vide notification dated 22.12.2010. The question arose regarding disbursement of the compensation, wherein the two brothers/petitioners concededly filed objection before the Revenue Officials exercising the powers under the Land Acquisition Act. Subsequently, on acquiring the complete title on conclusion of the aforesaid

civil dispute the petitioners filed CWP No.23563 of 2017, which was disposed of by directing the Authorities concerned to either release the compensation or to convey the reasons for non grant of the same.

At the time of hearing, it is conceded that the proper remedy is either to proceed under the Right to Information Act, 2005 or under the provisions of Land Acquisition Act, counsel prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
