The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 12.1.2017, vide which the respondents were directed to consider the representation filed by the petitioners, if any, within a period of one month.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the order has been complied with except qua petitioner No.5 .

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous qua petitioners No.1 to 4 and 6. The same is accordingly, dismissed qua respondents No.1 to 4 and 6.

However, the contempt petition qua petitioner No.5 is disposed of in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State that the respondents shall comply with the order qua petitioner No.5 within three weeks from today.

In case, the same has not been done as stated within the stipulated period, petitioner No.5 is at liberty to revive the contempt

petition.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
