Compliance report by way of affidavit of
Assistant Mining Engineer, Panipat-respondent No.2 has been filed in
Court. Copy supplied to the proxy counsel for the petitioner.

Having considered the order passed by this Court, contempt of
which is alleged and the affidavit of respondent No.2, wherein it has been
stated that the Sub Divisional Officer (C.), Karnal, Block Development &
Panchayat Officer, Karnal, and Assistant Mining Engineer, Panipat, have
looked into the matter in detail and have submitted a report and on
consideration whereof, the Deputy Commissioner, Karnal, has accepted the
same and found that there is no illegal mining taking place currently.
A speaking order dated 29.12.2017 (Annexure R-1) has also been appended
along with the affidavit. Affidavit of the Assistant Mining Engineer,
Panipat-respondent No.2 also states that same.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been
rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as such.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to avail of his remedy in accordance with law, if the action taken by the respondents according to the petitioner is not satisfactory.
