Petitioners had filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No.26111 of 2016*, seeking quashing the order dated 01.07.2016, whereby the juniors to the petitioners have been promoted.

The aforesaid writ petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 16.12.2016 (**Annexure P-1**), with a direction *'to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 12.08.2016 within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order passed by this Court. In case, the petitioners are found to be entitled for the relief sought in the legal notice, the same be granted to them within a period of two months thereafter. In case, the petitioners are still aggrieved in any*

manner, they are at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy available to them under the law.'

Since the needful was not done, hence, the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, a reply stands filed, wherein in Para No.2, it is stated that the legal notice dated 12.08.2016 made by the petitioners has since been decided by passing a speaking order dated 13.06.2017 **(Annexure R-1)** and the petitioners have been ordered to be promoted as Clerk w.e.f. 12.06.2014 i.e. the date from which the juniors to the petitioners were promoted.

In view of above, learned State counsel states that the order in question has been complied with, therefore, no further action in the present contempt is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
