This order shall dispose of two contempt petitions bearing COCP No.1447 of 2017 & 1448 of 2017, as common questions of facts and law are involved therein.

The contempt petitions have been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 27.02.2017. Admittedly, the arrears of rent have since been paid up till December, 2018. The only dispute appears qua the place, where the amount of arrears of rent is to be deposited. Both learned counsel for the parties have agreed that the rent now would be deposited at the office of Punjab Wakf Board, Ropar.

In view of the agreed position, the petitioners are directed to deposit the future rent as per the directions issued by this Court vide order dated 27.02.2017 with the Estate Officer, Punjab Wakf Board at Ropar.

Petitions stand dismissed.
