AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for petitioners contends that the petitioners No.1 and 3 have not been granted the ACP scale and have also not been granted pay equivalent to their juniors. This plea cannot be accepted in the present contempt petition in the light of the order passed by the Division Bench of this Court and the Hon'ble Supreme Court, where the claim was only restricted to grant of minimum pay scales to the employees. ACP Grade was not even the subject matter of the writ petition or the SLP.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to avail of the remedy in accordance with law with regard to their claims, which they may be entitled to and was not subject of the writ petition or the SLP.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
