I have considered the status report, which has been filed by the
respondents, according to which, now the slaughter is being carried out in
the slaughter houses and no illegal slaughter houses are in operation.

On the last date of hearing, opportunity was granted to the
petitioner to file a specific affidavit indicating the place and the incidence
where the illegal slaughter of animals is being carried out but in the

affidavit, which has been filed today, no such details are forthcoming except for a vague assertion that the illegal slaughter and the meat business is being carried out in violation of the Bye-laws of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973.

In view of the above, the Court is satisfied that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with.

It goes without saying that the respondents shall continue monitoring the aspect with regard to the slaughter and the sale of meat and shall ensure that the Rules and Bye-Laws, as framed under the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 are strictly complied with.

The present contempt petition stands disposed of accordingly.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged subject to above.
