AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court by filing the contempt petition for non-compliance of the order dated 10.02.2015 passed by this Court in CRM No.M-28106 of 2011, whereby directions were issued to the Crime Branch (Punjab) to complete the investigation within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

In the status report which has been filed on 24.01.2017, the reason why the delay has occurred in the process of investigation, has been given. It is further concluded that after carrying out various investigations including the polygraphic test etc. and after making every possible effort to trace the evidence in the FIR, nothing has yet been found by the investigating agency. The investigation, therefore, is complete.

In the light of the reply, which has been filed, this Court is satisfied that the intent and purpose of the order has been fully complied with.

Petitioner may avail of the remedy in accordance with law.

In case the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has not yet been filed, the same be filed before the competent Court within a period of 15 days.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
