By this order, I propose to dispose of COCP-1511-2017, titled
as 'Ajay Kumar & others Vs. A.K. Sinha & others', COCP-1512-2017, titled

COCP-1511-2017 & connected cases

as 'Manoj Kumar & others Vs. A.K. Sinha & others', COCP-1571-2017, titled as 'Rajesh Kumar & others Vs. A.K. Sinha & others' and COCP-1572-2017, titled as 'Harish Kumar & others Vs. A.K. Sinha & others'.

Counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Shri Atul Kumar, SDE, Water Supply and Sanitation Division No.1, Jalandhar, submits that the orders passed by this Court, which have attained finality upto the Hon'ble Supreme Court, have been duly complied with as the dues payable to the petitioners in pursuance to the said orders have been duly paid to them.

Counsel for the petitioners states that he has no specific instructions in this regard.

Keeping in view the statement given by the counsel for the respondents, on instructions, these contempt petitions are disposed of as infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive these contempt petitions in case the statement of the counsel for the respondents is found to be factually incorrect.

Liberty is also granted to the petitioners to move a representation in case the amounts which have been paid to them are not as per the dues payable to them. If such a representation is made by the petitioners within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be considered and decided by the Competent Authority within a period of six weeks from the date of submission of such representation. In case, the claim of the petitioners is found to be genuine, the amount due to the petitioners be disbursed to them within a further period of four weeks.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged subject to above.
