Petitioner-Rajesh Kumar, who is working as Multi Purpose Health Supervisor (Male) and is handicapped, had filed a complaint before the Court of learned Commissioner, Person with Disabilities, Haryana, regarding his transfer. The said complaint was allowed vide order dated 20.01.2017 (Annexure P-1), wherein it was directed to transfer the petitioner in District Panipat, near the place of his residence.

Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, a reply has been filed, wherein it is stated that in compliance of the order dated 20.01.2017 (**P-1**), passed by the Court of

learned Commissioner, Person with Disabilities, Haryana, the petitioner has been transferred from CHC Mullana, District Ambala to PHC Ujha, CHC Bapoli, District Panipat vide order dated 16.06.2017 (**Annexure R-1**).

In view of above, since the order dated 20.01.2017 (**P-1**) stands complied with, therefore, no further action in the present contempt is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
