The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 23.07.2016, vide which a direction was issued to the respondent to release the pensionary benefits to the petitioner as early as possible but not later than six months and the delayed payment shall carry 9% per annum interest.

Reply by way of affidavit of Manjit Singh Narang, Managing Director, Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala on behalf of the respondent has been filed. The same is taken on record.

As per the said reply, the order has been complied with and the interest amount towards Gratuity, leave encashment has been deposited in the account of the petitioner and the amount towards interest on GPF has since been paid by way of cheque to the petitioner.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. It is obvious that the petitioner is satisfied and he does not wish to pursue further with the present petition.

In view of above, the present petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, in case, the petitioner is aggrieved by passing of the said order or there is any discrepancy in the amount, he is at liberty to file the representation before the respondents, which shall be decided, in accordance with law.
