Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, no contempt is made out from the order of the trial Court. However, it is open to the petitioner to get the mutation corrected in tune with the ex parte decree dated 17.05.2016. He may even resort to any other legal remedy provided by law. The decree is open to execution and where execution is provided contempt proceedings cannot be initiated. Besides, any transfer of property during the pendency of the suit shall be subject to decree.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
