Status report has been filed by way of affidavit of Gurpreet Singh Bhullar. Copy has been supplied to the other side.

The order dated 27.2.2018 has been complied with since the SSP, District Jalandhar (Rural) has already passed speaking order dated 30.4.2018 (Annex. R-2/T). The investigation has revealed that the dispute is civil in nature and is between the petitioner and her in-laws. Besides, the matter is pending in the civil court. In the order dated 27.2.2018, no time schedule was fixed for the SSP to look into the matter. Once he has looked into the matter, the contempt is futile and discharged. Order has been purged. No further proceedings are required under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The police is directed that in future if any dispute arises between the parties, they will act as mediator and not as policemen.
