JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Satnam Singh) alleges the violation of the order dated 14.09.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by the Division Bench of this Court in *CWP No. 19036 of 2016*, wherein, while disposing of the petition, a direction was issued to the Estate Officer, HUDA, District Panipat, to take a decision on the representation dated 28.04.2016 of the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time of three months, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, a reply filed in Court today is taken on record. In reply, it is stated that in compliance of the order dated 14.09.2016 (**P-1**), a speaking order dated 03.04.2017 (**Annexure R-1**) after personal hearing of the petitioner, stands passed, and copy of the same has also been conveyed to the petitioner.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner concedes that the order in question has been complied with, therefore, no further action in the present contempt is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.
