The four petitioners are working as Clerks in the various Estate Offices under the Haryana Urban Development Authority. They filed CWP NO.21558 of 2013, which was allowed vide order dated 7.9.2017, thereby the order to withdraw the exemption earlier granted for passing the English typist test was set aside. They were held entitled to the benefit of exemption.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners contents that pursuant to such declaratory relief, the respondents-Authorities are not granting the consequential benefit of release, by withholding the increments as also promotion.

Counsel for the petitioners heard.

Concededly, the consequential relief would provide a separate cause of action, for which the petitioners have a separate remedy. Thus no

contempt is made out.

Dismissed.
