After Neelam Rani's case was decided, several writ petitions were filed which led to the State Government to issue policy instructions dated 21.11.2017 giving rights to the employees in the Education Department to make representations for their cases for stepping up of pay with that of their juniors to be considered. In view of the executive instructions notified on 21.11.2017, this contempt petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondents to decide the case of the petitioner in light of the directions issued by this Court in CWP No. 14830 of 2017 Ram Parsad Vs. State of Haryana decided on 20.12.2017. The case of the petitioner be decided within two months from the date of the receipt of a certified copy of this order and the benefits falling due, be disbursed within the same time.

With the above observations and directions, the present petition is disposed of.
