Petitioner-Parveen Kumar (husband) had filed an appeal bearing FAO No. 5868 of 2015, directed against the judgment and decree dated 20.05.2015 passed by the District Judge, Family Court, Rohtak, whereby the petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the husband-wife (petitioner-respondent) was dismissed at the stage of second motion, when the respondent-wife did not make a statement agreeing to the divorce by mutual consent.

The aforesaid appeal bearing *FAO No. 5868 of 2015* was dismissed, vide order dated 16.10.2015 (**Annexure P-1**), passed by a Division Bench of this Court, with the direction to the respondent-wife '*to return by way of a demand draft ₹ 3,00,000/-, to the appellant, within fifteen days from receipt of certified copy of this order*'.

Since the needful was not done within the prescribed time,

hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, a reply stands filed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the compromise has been effected between the parties, therefore, wishes to withdraw the present contempt petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
