AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

A perusal of the reply/affidavit, which has been filed by the Financial Commissioner, Rural Development and Panchayat, shows that all the departmental enquiries pending against him stand concluded. Only FIR No.152 dated 06.11.2018 is pending against the petitioner at Police Station Talwandi Sabo in District Bathinda. On consideration of the claim of the petitioner, a speaking order dated 06.09.2018 (Annexure R-2) has been passed by the Special Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats. Further order dated 06.09.2018 (Annexure R-3) indicates that provisional pension has also been sanctioned and an amount of ₹10,820/- is fixed for the period from 01.09.2018 to 31.08.2019 and 01.09.2019 to 31.08.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, states that the order passed in the enquiry, which has been concluded against the petitioner, has not been supplied to the petitioner.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions, states that copy of the order has already been sent to the petitioner. He, however, states that another copy of the order would be supplied to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such. The petitioner, if so advised, may avail of his remedy in accordance with law in case he is not satisfied with the order passed by the respondent.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
