Notice of motion.

On the asking of court, Mr.Aditya Sharda, AAG, Punjab
accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Petitioners allege violation of order dated 30.1.2018 passed by
this court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to
respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the
petitioners in the above said legal notice (P-10) and to take a
conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a
period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified
copy of this order.

However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any
of the order(s) passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be
at liberty to approach this court.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that in case
representation is still pending, decision shall be taken thereon at the

earliest in any case not later than two weeks.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, petition is disposed of. In case, any fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioners to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, apart from initiating proceedings under the Act, it shall consider imposition of punitive costs which shall be deducted from the salary of official(s) responsible for delay/non-compliance.
