The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 09.11.2017 vide which a direction was issued to respondent No.3 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 07.07.2017 of the petitioner.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Raj Kumar, Executive Engineer, HSVP Division, Sonipat has been filed. As per reply, the order dated 09.11.2017 has been complied with by passing a speaking order dated 10.09.2018. In fact in pursuance to the said speaking order, the respondents have already issued an order dated 19.09.2018 vide which the petitioner is held regularized from 01.04.1993 by re-fixing the pay scale as 950-20-1150-EB-25-1400.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to deposit the arrears within one month from today. In case, the compliance is not made within one month, the present petition shall stand revived.
