JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Harish Chander) stands retired on 31.05.2015 from the post of Lineman after attaining the age of superannuation from the Office of XEN, UHBVNL, Panipat. The writ petition bearing *CWP No. 8742 of 2016* filed by him claiming counting of his daily wage period prior to the regularization in service towards qualifying service for grant of pension was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 06.05.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to pass a speaking order on legal notice dated 17.01.2016 issued by the petitioner, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time of four months, the present contempt petition has been filed.

Upon notice, a reply stands filed, wherein it is stated the in compliance of the order dated 06.05.2016 (**P-1**), a speaking order dated

07.09.2017 (**Annexure R-1**), granting the claimed relief to the petitioner,

has been passed.

In view of above, counsel for the respondents states that no further action in the present contempt is warranted.

Dismissed.

Rule is discharged.
