JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners' claim that the husband-wife, duo/respondents had agreed to refund the amounts collected by them from the petitioners towards promise for sending them abroad vide a written settlement dated 30.01.2014 (**Annexure P-2**), drawn up before the Mediator of the Mediation Centre of this Court. The said mediation was adopted in the pending criminal case bearing **CRM-M No. 25984 of 2013**, titled as '*Sukhpreet Kaur and another Versus State of Punjab and others*', i.e., at the instance of the respondents.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, no case for invoking the contempt jurisdiction is made out, as concededly no order has been passed accepting the aforesaid settlement deed dated 30.01.2014 (**P-2**) as a part of any order. It is further conceded that the aforesaid case bearing **CRM-M No. 25984 of 2013** stands dismissed vide order dated 10.10.2014.

In view of above, no case for further action in the present contempt petition is warranted, therefore, the same is **dismissed**.
