The petitioner had filed CWP No.3708 of 2017 for quashing the letter/Show Cause Notice dated 04.09.2015 in respect of her selection and appointment to the post of PGT Punjabi. The said petition was disposed of by learned Single Judge of this Court, vide order dated 27.02.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) with direction to the respondent-Authority to take appropriate decision on the petitioner's reply dated 28.09.2015 to the Show Cause Notice dated 04.09.2015 within a period of four weeks from the date of passing of that order. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply by way of affidavit of the respondent stands filed, wherein it is stated that the claim of the petitioner has been considered and the same has been rejected by passing a detailed speaking order dated 28.12.2017 (**Annexure R-1**).

Learned Counsel for the respondent submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the directions were to decide the matter, which stand complied with.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is dismissed as infructuous.

The petitioner is free to challenge the aforesaid speaking order in accordance with law.
