The petitioner had filed CWP No.14275 of 2014 seeking directions to the respondent-Education Department to reinstate the petitioner in service with all consequential benefits. The said petition was allowed by this Court, vide order dated 08.02.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) with directions to the respondents to take back the petitioner in service with all consequential benefits except any salary for the period, the petitioner has not worked. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply stands filed, wherein it is stated that the claim of the petitioner has been considered and the petitioner has been reinstated in service as Hindi Master, vide order dated 20.07.2017 (**Annexure R-1**).

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondents submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the aforesaid directions have already been complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned opposite Counsel.

In view of above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
