JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-Kesar Singh, alleges the violation of the order dated 23.01.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), passed in *CWP No.258 of 2012*, whereby this Court had directed '*to the respondents to release the complete pension of the petitioner alongwith the gratuity, with liberty to the Department to conclude the enquiry in accordance with law, permitting the authorities to pass an order after following rules within three months, and the petitioner shall also be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum on the delayed payment starting three months from the date of retirement till the date of payment.*'

Upon notice, a reply has been filed, wherein it is stated that by passing an order dated 09.05.2017 (**Annexure R-1**) and after calculating the

payment alongwith interest (**Annexure R-2**), two cheques amounting to Rs.6,50,145/- and Rs.1,14,918/- stand released in favour of the petitioner *qua* the complete pension and gratuity alongwith interest @ 9% per annum starting three months from the date of his retirement till the date of payment.

In view of above, learned counsel for the respondents states that the order dated 23.01.2017 (**P-1**) has been complied with, therefore, no further action in the present contempt petition is warranted.

Disposed of as infructuous.

However, if there is any discrepancy in calculation sheet, petitioner will make a representation before the competent authority within a period of three months from today.
