JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners, three (03) in number, who are serving as 'J.B.T.' Teachers under the Haryana State Education Department, had filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No. 17652 of 2016, inter alia*, directing to respondents therein for grant of pay at par with their junior employees in the J.B.T. Cadre, as they were drawing higher pay and emoluments.

The aforesaid writ petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 29.08.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the Director, School Education, Panchkula (respondent No. 2 therein) *'to take a final decision on the legal notice dated 23.08.2016 of the petitioners, by passing a speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order'*.

Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time of four months, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply stands filed. In reply at para No. 3, it is stated that after considering legal notice of the petitioners, a detailed speaking order dated 22.03.2017 (**Annexure R-1**) has been passed, fixing their pay at par with their juniors subject to the outcome of LPA filed by the Department against the orders.

In view of above, counsel for the respondent that the order in question has been complied with, therefore, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition, as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.
