The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 24.7.2015, vide which direction was issued to decide the legal notice of the petitioner by passing a speaking order after affording opportunity of hearing to him.

Reply has been filed. As per the said reply, legal notice of the petitioner has since been decided by way of passing a speaking order dated 3.9.2015 by the Directorate Local Government Punjab. Copy of the same is annexed as Annexure R-1. Thereafter, in continuation of the order dated 3.9.2015, Directorate Local Government Punjab has passed final speaking orders dated 23.2.2017 and 27.4.2017, whereby the demands in legal notice have been decided and all due payments have been paid. However, interest has been denied on the ground that there is no provision.

In view of above, the present petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, in case the petitioner is aggrieved with the passing of the said orders in any manner, he is at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.

Rule against the respondents stands discharged.
