The bar of Section 20 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 has come into operation. Too much time has gone by with the petitioner – association watching the transformation of the shops multiplying on the sides of the road like a virus. The petitioner association deserves to be seen all these years as a bystander to mushrooming growth of commercial and residential buildings. Thus, no contempt is made out to initiate proceedings.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.

However, petitioner association is at liberty to seek its regular remedies before the appropriate agency or in fresh litigation, if advised and warranted in law.
