The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 8.11.2017, vide which the writ petition was disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into the representation dated 2.9.2017 filed by the petitioner.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sudhanshu Shekhar Srivastava, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Amritsar dated 27.11.2018 has been filed in Court today. Copy supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

As per reply, the matter was enquired into and the representation of the petitioner was decided, which is placed on record as Annexure R-5. The allegations were found to be false in the enquiry. It has been found that the dispute is of civil in nature and the matter is already pending before the civil authority.

In view of the above, this Court finds that the order has been complied with and the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous. The same is accordingly dismissed.

The Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
