Affidavit of Ramesh Kumar, Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Rampura Phul, District Bathinda, has been filed in court today. Same is taken on record. Learned counsel has referred to Paras 4 and 5 thereof. Same read as under:-

“4. That after security of the records, it transpired that following amounts are liable to be paid to the petitioners:-

5. *That out of the total due amount of Rs.13,33,389/-, an amount of Rs.1,83,389/- is due to be paid to the petitioner. It is pertinent to mention here that the balance due amount of Rs.1,83,389/- shall be paid by the deponent within period of 4 weeks.”*
