The writ petition bearing *CWP No.6117 of 2017*, filed by the petitioner (Lokesh), seeking direction to Director, School Education, Panchkula, was disposed of vide order dated 03.05.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), with the direction '*to decide petitioner's representation by passing a speaking order within any reasonable time.*'

Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, a reply dated 08/09.11.2017 of Shri Rajiv Rattan, Director Secondary Education Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector 5,

Panchkula/respondent No.2 herein has been filed, wherein, it is stated that the representation dated 12.05.2017 of the petitioner has been decided and detailed speaking order dated 22.08.2017 (**Annexure R-1**) has been passed.

In view of above, learned counsel for the parties concede that since the order dated 03.05.2017 (**P-1**) stands complied with, therefore, no further action in the present contempt is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.

However, if the petitioner is still aggrieved, he is free to challenge the order dated 22.08.2017 (**R/1**), in accordance with law.
