Petitioner filed a writ for Habeas Corpus for production of his wife Anjali who had been forcibly removed from his custody by strangers Rajesh Kumar, Chattarpal and Krishana Lali. Upon notice the learned State Counsel produced the copy of the DDR No.13 wherein it was recorded that the said Anjali Azad alleged wife gave a statement in the Court that she was not ready to go and live with the petitioner Manoj Parshad. The petitioner-husband thus was granted the opportunity to seek his available legal remedies. As regards the plea that he was receiving threats from said strangers on his mobile. SSP, Mohali was directed to look into the matter and take appropriate action vide order dated 18.08.2017.

Since allegedly no action has been taken by the SSP Mohali, present contempt has been filed.

After hearing Counsel for the petitioner, no ground for

invoking contempt jurisdiction is made out. The petitioner with regard to the alleged threats is free to seek his remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed.
