Two cheques amounting to ₹2,32,500/- and ₹10,500/- respectively, total ₹2,43,000/-(which relates to the subsistence allowance for the period from 03.03.2005 to January, 2018) have been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner. Copy of the enquiry report dated 26.02.2005 has also been handed over.

Counsel for the parties agree that the petitioner would appear before the Managing Committee of the Vaish Education Society, Rohtak on 12.09.2018 at 11 A.M. for personal hearing.

It goes without saying that the petitioner will have to submit an affidavit to the effect that he had not worked during the period, for which subsistence allowance has been paid to him i.e. from 03.03.2005 to August, 2018. This affidavit be also filed on the same date i.e. 12.09.2018. The arrears, if any, be also released to the petitioner on the said date.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed

of as having been rendered infructuous.

It is made clear that in case the Managing Committee does not pay the petitioner the salary/subsistence allowance by 7th of each month, liberty would be available to the petitioner to revive the contempt petition as per the order passed by this Court.
