JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Rajinder Kumar) was working as a *Beldar* with the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana, and was claiming promotion to the post of *Fitter*, that apart it was claimed that the promotion of the private respondents in writ petition bearing *CWP No. 2453 of 2012* filed by him was required to be reviewed. The aforesaid writ petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 23.08.2013 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana, to finalize the rules/regulation governing the post, and thereafter, consider the cases for review of the promotions.

Since the exercise was not conducted within the stipulated period of six months, hence the present contempt petition was filed.

Upon notice, it is stated that the rules were finalized by the Municipal Corporation on 20.12.2014, however, were approved by the

Government on 28.02.2017, and thereafter, the review of the promotion was conducted. In sum and substance, it is stated that the order dated 23.08.2013 (P-1) has been complied with.

In view of aforesaid situation, no further proceedings are warranted in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of.

Rule is discharged.
