AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for respondents No. 1 and 3 states that the amount due to the petitioners has been deposited in the shape of FDR (Annexure R-1/2), which will be transferred in the account of Sub-Divisional Magistrate-cum-Land Acquisition Collector, Gurdaspur, within a period of one month from today to be disbursed to the petitioners.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for respondents No.1 and 3, the present contempt petition is disposed of with directions to the Sub-Divisional Magistrate-cum-Land Acquisition Collector, Gurdaspur-respondent No.2 to disburse the amount to the petitioners within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the amount from the Project Director-respondent No.3.

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Liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the present contempt petition in case the statement as made by the counsel for respondents No.1 and 3 is not honoured or the directions given to the Sub-Divisional Magistrate-cum-Land Acquisition Collector, Gurdaspur-respondent No.2, are not complied with.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged subject to above.
