No time limit is fixed in the order dated 22.12.2017 passed in CRM-M-49417-2017, therefore, the question of contempt does not arise. See Union of India Vs.M/s Oswal Woolen Mills and others, AIR 1984 SC 1264.

If the petitioner is dissatisfied or aggrieved by any of the jeopardizes against those he accuses of commission of crime, he is free to take recourse to regular remedies available to him in law.

In view of the observations made above, the present petition is dismissed with the liberty aforesaid.
