Petitioners have approached this Court alleging violation of the order dated 13.11.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 25726 of 2017 preferred by the petitioners, wherein direction was issued to the Collector, Gurdaspur to decide the application preferred by the petitioners dated 24.04.2017 for recall of the ex-parte order dated 28.10.2010, which was pending, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. Counsel contends that the said order dated 13.11.2017 has not been complied with rather the Collector has manipulated the records and had passed an order dated 12.07.2017 and on that basis, passed the impugned order dated 23.05.2018 alleging that the said order is in violation of the order passed by this Court.

This contention of the learned counsel for the petitioners cannot be accepted as it appears that the petitioners have not mentioned this

fact in the writ petition that the order has already been passed on the application, which has been submitted by the petitioners on 24.04.2017 for setting aside the ex-parte order dated 28.10.2010. No contempt of Court against the respondents is, therefore, made out.

The present petition being devoid of merits stands dismissed.
