JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Abhiraj Verma) alleges the violation of the order dated 22.06.2018 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this Court in writ petition bearing *CWP No. 15619 of 2018* filed by him, wherein the directions were issued 'to the respondent-Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) to declare the result of the re-evaluation sought by the petitioner in the stated subjects therein on or before 29.06.2018 by 5 PM without waiting for receiving of process charges which is scheduled for 25.06.2018, if any, subject to the completion of process by the petitioner on 25.06.2018.

Since after depositing of process charges by the petitioner on 25.06.2018, re-evaluation result of the petitioner was not declared, hence the present contempt petition has been filed.

At the time of hearing, counsel for the petitioner concedes that re-evaluation result of the petitioner has been declared, therefore, no further action in the present contempt petition is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
