Petitioner is alleged to have been duped by a Builder. This Court in the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.PC vide order dated 6.4.2018 had directed the SSP to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

This court is not inclined to invoke the contempt jurisdiction merely to be used as a tool for registration of FIR. The appropriate remedy for the petitioner is to approach the Magistrate under Section 156(3) Cr.PC.
