Petitioner is stated to have been engaged as Cycle Chowkidar on Daily Wage basis in September 2000 and his services were dispensed with in the year 2004. The petitioner raised an industrial dispute and the finally Labour Court vide Award dated 10.10.2013 dismissed the claim of the petitioner. The petitioner filed CWP No.655 of 2014 challenging the Award and the learned Single Judge vide order dated 29.04.2015 allowed the claim of the petitioner and directed the reinstatement of the petitioner with continuity of service and 50% back wages. The LPA filed by the College was dismissed vide order dated 23.7.2015 thus affirming the order passed by the learned Single Judge. Even the SLP filed by the Management was dismissed in limni vide order dated 09.02.2018. The petitioner is stated to have been reinstated in compliance of directions passed by learned Single

Judge on 19.09.2016.

Now the services of the petitioner as a temporary employee have been ordered to be relieved vide order dated 28.05.2018 (**P-8**) and thus the petitioner has filed the present contempt alleging violation of the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

At the time of hearing, realising that the contempt is not maintainable, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present contempt to enable his client to avail appropriate remedy.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
