The petitioner had filed CRM-M No.10283 of 2016, restricting his prayer with regard to consider his representation dated 20.02.2016 moved to the respondent-SSP, Patiala. The said petition was disposed of by learned Single Judge of this Court, vide order dated 22.03.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) with direction to the respondent-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the said representation dated 20.02.2016 and pass appropriate order within two months, as per law, after receiving copy of that order. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, status report by way of affidavit dated 07.09.2016 of the respondent stands filed, wherein it is stated that the representation of petitioner has been considered and the same has been filed by passing a speaking order dated 25.05.2016 (**Annexure R-2**).

Learned Counsel for the respondent submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the aforesaid directions stand complied with.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

The petitioner is free to seek the remedy, available with him, in accordance with law.
