Reply by way of affidavit of the District Education Officer (Elementary Education), Sri Muktsar Sahib – respondent No.2, dated 04.10.2017, has been filed in Court, which is taken on record.

As per the said affidavit, on considering the claim of the petitioners, most of the petitioners have been granted the benefit of arrears on refixation of pay. As regards petitioners No.5, 21, 70, 73, 96 to 98, 116, 123, 127 and 151 have been found to be not eligible for the benefit and qua them, a speaking order dated 22.09.2017 (Annexure R-4) has been passed by the District Education Officer (Elementary Education), Sri Muktsar Sahib.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous. Disposed of as such. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioners referred to above to avail of their remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
