The petitioner-Company had earlier filed CWP No.7009 of 2014 seeking a direction to the revenue officials for demarcation of the 22 acres of land, owned by the petitioner-Company, released from the acquisition. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 11.04.2014 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to decide the application for demarcation under the Punjab Land Revenue Act within three months from the date of receipt of such an application.

Upon notice, an affidavit of the Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estates, Faridabad has been filed, wherein the circumstances of due compliance of the directions have been stated.

Learned Counsel for the respondents points out that in the light of the assertions of the aforesaid affidavit, the present contempt petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is dismissed as infructuous.
