The petitioner is stated to have retired on attaining the age of superannuation from privately managed aided college-SGGS Khalsa College, Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur. His claim for balance of House Rent Allowance w.e.f. 01.9.1997 to 01.8.1999 and from 13.9.2004 to 31.1.2008 and interest on delayed payment of retiral benefits was not being paid, hence, he filed CWP No.16924 of 2011, which was disposed of vide order dated 16.2.2017 with a direction to do the needful within three months.

Since the required relief was not released, hence, the present

contempt petition.

Upon notice, learned counsel for respondents put in appearance and state that the required payments have been made.

In response, counsel for the petitioner concedes that nothing more is due and the order passed by this Court stands duly complied with.
